This year's tour will feature Southern Missouri, following the former St. Louis Iron Mountain & Southern, Missouri Pacific, and a few Frisco depots as well.

The tour will include:

- Bonne Terre, MO – Missouri Pacific - a unique 2 story structure, currently a Bed & Breakfast
- Park Hills, MO – Mississippi River & Bonne Terre RR (later Missouri Pacific)
- Bismarck – Missouri Pacific – currently under renovation into a museum & community center
- Arcadia-Ironton – Missouri Pacific – a unique stone building which is currently an interesting museum with a DT&I caboose.
- Fredericktown – Missouri Pacific – restored but currently unoccupied
- Piedmont – Missouri Pacific – currently in use by Union Pacific. A unique stone structure.
- Poplar Bluff – Frisco – currently the MOARK Model Railroad Club and Museum
- Poplar Bluff – Missouri Pacific – This station is undergoing an extensive renovation. Part of the building is still used by Amtrak.
